



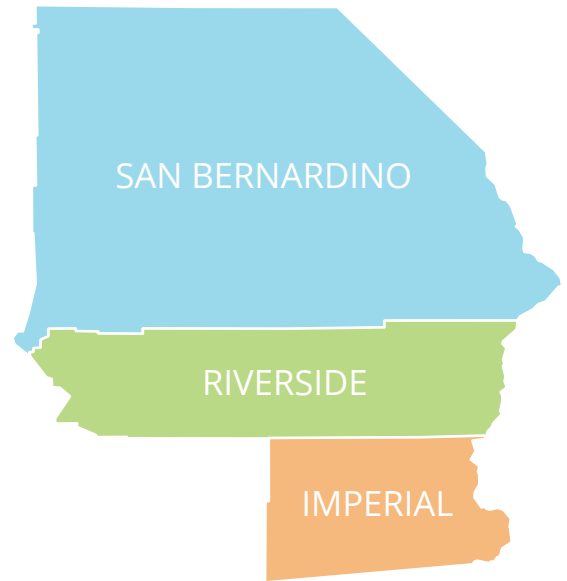
# ISC3

## KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE

### Regional Convenings & Capacity-Building Trainings

ISC3 organizes regional convenings, member meetings, workshops and trainings to foster knowledge exchange, collaboration and mutual support to achieve shared regional goals.

### Regional & Statewide Newsletters

Members receive curated newsletters from ISC3 (regional) and ARCCA (statewide), which include relevant news, funding opportunities, events, and resources on a regular basis.
